

Rules and Regulations

All golfers must register in the clubhouse prior to tee off.

- Outside beverages are prohibited from golf course property. Beverages are available for purchase within the clubhouse. Failure to comply will result in confiscation of beverages and dismissal from the course.
- Maximum of four people in a group. Larger groups will be asked to separate.
- No jumping of holes - play all holes consecutively. No golfer shall interrupt the play of another golfer by cutting in front of them on an empty hole.
- Damage to rental carts and/or to course property is grounds for dismissal from the course. Damages are the financial responsibility of the committing golfer.
- Do not drive carts within 30 feet of greens and tee boxes.
- Practice is allowed on the practice green and driving range only. No one is allowed on individual holes for practice shots.
- Only one ball in play allowed to each golfer unless playing a provisional.
- No more than two golfers per cart.
- Repair all ball marks on greens. Replace all divots on tee boxes and in fairways. Rake bunkers.
- Do not hold up the play of other golfers—let faster groups play through.
- Golfers under the age of 16 are prohibited from driving golf carts on course property.
- Glasses bottles are not allowed on the golf course.
- No fishing from the bank/bridges on golf course property. No wading in water for golf balls.
- The course is closed Mondays until noon for course maintenance and on Wednesday evenings for league.
- All USGA rules and regulations apply.
